# AWARD SELECTION PROCESS

Awards campaign starts with published Ads of “Calls for Nomination” on the official Instagram handle, Website, TV, and Radio channels.

GAH-AWARDS Nomination packets **MUST** include a minimum of 25 entries on [www.gahawards.com](http://www.gahawards.com) from the general public. Names of all individuals and organizations meeting this quota are forwarded by the organizing committee to the Jury Panel.

The Jury Panel includes members of the Awards advisory board and a few other appointees as selected unanimously by the advisory board which would include two at least two past winners and certain individuals selected based on individual industry specialization and experience.

Once nominations close on the awards website, the Jury Panel carries out considerable study on the individuals and business entities that have been nominated in each category and who have demonstrated exceptional humanitarian and entrepreneurial corporate social responsibility with verifiable proof. The Jury Panel forwards a summary report of findings to the GAH-AWARDS Organizing Committee for final conferment of award titles and the award category winners are communicated to accordingly.

This year, in celebration of GAH-AWARDS 10th Anniversary, Awards would be presented in over 35 categories in Humanitarian achievement areas, and in addition to that up-to 8 honorary awards including but not limited to:

GAH-AWARDS: Personality for Human Capacity Development, Humanitarian for Human Capital Development, Humanitarian for women Empowerment, and Capacity Building, The most prestigious Life time Achievement Award etc.

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


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# GAH-AWARDS 10th Anniversary

However, we are starting with the first lucky batch of one hundred beneficiaries in our midst who are passionate about becoming fashion designers but lack the necessary funding to join our prestigious institution, GMYT Fashion Academy, with a twelve-month scholarship covering hostel accommodation, machine empowerment, and so on.

As the GMD of GMYT Group, I have always maintained that skill acquisition is the answer to Nigeria's socio-economic imbalance in the international space as well as the remedy for gender-based violence in the country. It is therefore sad that we have not fulfilled the wishes of those seventeen thousand requests but I believe that having you all in this hall today can rekindle the hope of these women and youth.

Therefore, this is the call to action, to join this chariot for GAH-AWARDS 2023 by championing the next phase as we have three categories of foundation students in our midst today:

The first category of students is the GMYT Foundation graduating

students who require your support in terms of start-up capital, grants, coaching, and mentorship opportunities to help structure their new businesses for sustainability.

The second category is the GMYT Foundation beneficiaries, who got GMYT tuition scholarships. This group will be requiring resource materials, sewing machines for their practical work at home and logistics support in terms of accommodation space in GMYT Hostel and transportation costs where applicable for their rigorous but exciting 12-month program.

Sponsorship avenues also exist for the third set of prospective beneficiaries online through the GMYT online program. These candidates are not residents of Lagos and cannot relocate and/or benefit from the hostel accommodation but still want the opportunity.

Having you here today is a great honour for the entire GMYT Group.

Thank you for helping us build this platform over the last decade, we are grateful. Together, we will make a positive difference in the lives of the women and youth in our society.



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

I manage an NGO duly registered in Nigeria names Tabitha New Life Foundation. (TNLF).

#### **Who We Are**

Our sole objective is to provide succour to Widows and Widowers in the society.

#### **What We Do**

In line with our vision and mission, our aim is to ameliorate the physical and psychological trauma emanating from the death of loved ones and to empower Widows and Widowers in the society, in our noble way.

Tabitha New Life Foundation's mandate is to reach out to and dislodge our target group of Widows & Widowers from the state of idleness and despondency, giving them hope to rise above poverty, chart a new course, change their pattern of life and hopefully embrace various entrepreneurial opportunities to brighten their horizon. This is in line with our motto: Hope & Service.

#### **Achievements:**

We organize on monthly basis, skills Acquisition and empowerment programs for widows and widowers.

Recently, academic materials were donated to the children of widows and widowers to support their study and relieve their single parents of the pressure on the meagre resources they use for trading.

In 2020, we gave out 2 grinding machines, 2 popcorn machines and 3 sewing machines, 8 gas cylinders and burners. We also reached out to Widows on the street and their children. Taking them off the street and established them in their chosen businesses.

Also, In 2021, 10 crushing (grinding) machines, 6 sewing machines, 3 popcorn machines, 10 camp gases, 3 cylinders, 5 table burners were given out to different beneficiaries for empowerment.

In August 2022, we were able to reach out to 64 Widows with 10 grinding machines, 10 Sewing Machines, 5 Popcorn Machines, 10 Gas cylinders, 2 Hair dryers, Industrial cooking gas, Table burners and lots more.

From the afore-mentioned parameters, we are still on track as defined by our vision but far from accomplishing the enormous tasks before us in order to make the world a better place.





# PROMOTING SUSTAINABLE ECONOMIC GROWTH THROUGH SKILL ACQUISITION

**D**evelopment is critical and essential to the sustenance of any Nation. Thus, Governments of all Nations delineate their Developmental Goals and aspire to attain them. However, for a Nation to attain an acceptable level of Development, it must have well-planned and implemented Developmental Strategies, geared towards socio-economic progress which involves all citizens. This presumes that individual citizens, of course, are adequately educated and well-trained to be able to play their roles in achieving National Goals. They must be equipped with relevant Technical, Employable, and Entrepreneurship Skills. This is especially so in today's knowledge-driven economy, where technically skilled people are increasingly being recognized as critical factors for National Development.

In cognizance of this, successive Nigerian Governments since Independence have put in place, Plans and Strategies to attain National Development. In fact, the first National Development Plan from 1962 to 1968, emphasized Technical Education, among other factors, for achieving set goals. Since then, there have been other National Development Plans.

## ECONOMIC GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT

Economic development is the process by which a nation improves the economic, political, and social well-being of its people. Economic development comes with modernization, industrialization, and general improvement in the environment and the well-being of the people. This would logically lead to an increase in literacy rate, increase in life expectancy, decrease in the poverty rate, and improvement in education and health of a nation.

The economic development of a nation is affected by the capability of governments to do the following:

- To implement plans, policies, and budgets that will lead to price stability, high employment rate, effective tax, effective regulation, trade, and availability of finance for business.
- Provision of infrastructure and public services such as roads, power, housing, portable borne water, health services, education, security, and agriculture.

- Job creation through creating the enabling environment for business, skills acquisition, technology transfer and focus on high employment generating sectors such as agriculture, mining, tourism, infrastructure, and ICT services among others. (Igbuzor, Ph.D.)

Every human being needs diverse kinds of skills to live a meaningful life. Skills are required both for individuals to live meaningful and successful lives as well as to develop nations.

Unfortunately, many people and countries do not place a lot of emphasis on skills acquisition leading to failures in life, mediocrity, and underdevelopment.

The Productivity Capacity of the citizens of a nation determines the economic growth of such a nation. However, to facilitate Productivity Capacity, skills acquisition and job creation are some of the required ingredients. It is equally trite that these components are key determinants in the realization of economic growth since the human resource has been identified as the key driver of nations the world over.

### Concept of Skills Acquisition


Skill acquisition is the process by which individuals are exposed to learning and continuous practices in a particular task till the learner becomes proficient in the operation and can perform them when required.

Social and ultimately, National Development, but also sources of devastating socio-political tension and conflict when not gainfully and productively engaged. According to CIA World Factbook Demographic Statistics(2011), about 55.9% of Nigerians between the ages 15-64 (the most vibrant and active population) are jobless. Resultantly, Nigeria's economic growth has been hampered. National Bureau of Statistics, notes that the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) of Nigeria is growing at the rate of 7.4% in the 3rd quarter of 2011 while the unemployment level is 23.9%. Ikem (2011), also points out that Nigeria was ranked the 17th poorest Country in the World by United Nations' Human Development Index (HDI) in 2011.

In the face of the growing level of unemployment, coupled with other problems including political decadence, social inequality, dysfunctional physical, social and economic infrastructure, unprecedented fall in capacity utilization rate in the industry, rising levels of crime, and neglect of the Agricultural Sector; putting the economy back on the path of recovery and growth will require assisting citizens to become self-reliant. Emphasizing the importance of self-reliance for job seekers, former Vice President, Atiku Abubakar (2001) urged that;

*The poor and unemployed population must begin to appreciate the option of being self-reliant rather than waiting for the Government's patronage... We cannot just sit back in our homes and imagine that because we have acquired some education, nothing more is required of us... Equipped with that education, we should learn to use our hands and to produce. This is the best solution to poverty and unemployment.*

However, to attain self-reliance and be self-sustaining, individuals must be equipped with Employable and Entrepreneurial Skills. These Skills, of course, must be acquired through well-designed and implemented Education and Training which can be both formal and informal. In fact, it is confirmed that continuous enhancement of productivity through Skills Acquisition is very central to the brilliant performance of the Asian Tigers in recent years (World Bank; 1993).

As part of the key indices necessary for adequate national development, therefore, it follows that the ability for improvement and sustenance of socio-economic development must be predicated on the development of a skilled workforce.

It is also expected that structures and processes for transferring such skills and competencies from one group of workers to another and from one generation of citizens to another should be firmly established. Clearly, economic development cannot be fully realized without a skilled workforce as it implies not merely per capita growth in income; but also social integration and an equal sharing of responsibility and power.

If poverty and unemployment trend especially of the Youth is left to persist, there is a growing risk of greater inequalities, social and economic instability, and insecurity across the nation. Recognizing the urgency of this issue, the International Labour Organisation (ILO) decided to address the "Youth employment crisis" at its 10th Session of the International Labour Conference (ILC) that took place in Geneva in June 2012. Many far-reaching decisions were taken aimed at reducing the employment crisis and creating wealth.

These decisions have been enshrined in many of the Transformation Agenda or Vision of African Nations. However, it should be noted that Government alone cannot adequately tackle Skills Development and employment crisis due to the enormous resources (both material and human) required to ensure that all citizens possess employable skills. It has been found that to attain the people-oriented goal of assisting all citizens to acquire relevant skills, a decentralized, Public-Private - Partnership approach is always desirable.

This is where GMYT has come to play a very significant role within the Nigerian economy by training youth in skill acquisition in the area of Tailoring and Fashion Design. Giving sponsorship to youth in her Academy and providing them with accommodation is another measure to ensure that this effort would produce skilled individuals who would in turn employ other youth when they eventually set up their own businesses.

The GAH-AWARDS is a recognition of sponsors of this laudable entrepreneurship skills acquisition initiative who believe in the positive returns of the program, both to the individual and to the nation.

With the support of private individuals and the government, the agency is sure to expand its scope of operation to accommodate a larger number of trainees who will in turn contribute towards the nation's economic growth. All that is needed now is more support and encouragement from both sectors.

## CONCLUSION

Nigeria, through many Programs, Strategies, Parastatals and Agencies have done a lot in preparing her citizens to acquire Employable and Entrepreneurial Skills. Unfortunately, the Skills level remains low, while unemployment persists in Nigeria. It becomes evident that there is a need for better proactive actions in Entrepreneurship Development and Skills Acquisition programs.

There is a need to enthrone a secure and poverty-free nation for all citizens to become contributing members of society. Unemployment, hunger, homelessness, lack of security, social vices, and sickness must not continue

to be paramount issues in Nigeria.

To address the issues outlined, respective Stakeholders involved in Entrepreneurial and Skills Acquisition programs and indeed, all well-meaning Nigerians, must play their roles and live up to their responsibilities. It is my sincere belief that Nigerians can rise to the demands of Entrepreneurship Development and Skills Acquisition. It is in taking serious decisions and implementing the decisions that they will liberate themselves from the adversities of today and the fears of tomorrow.
